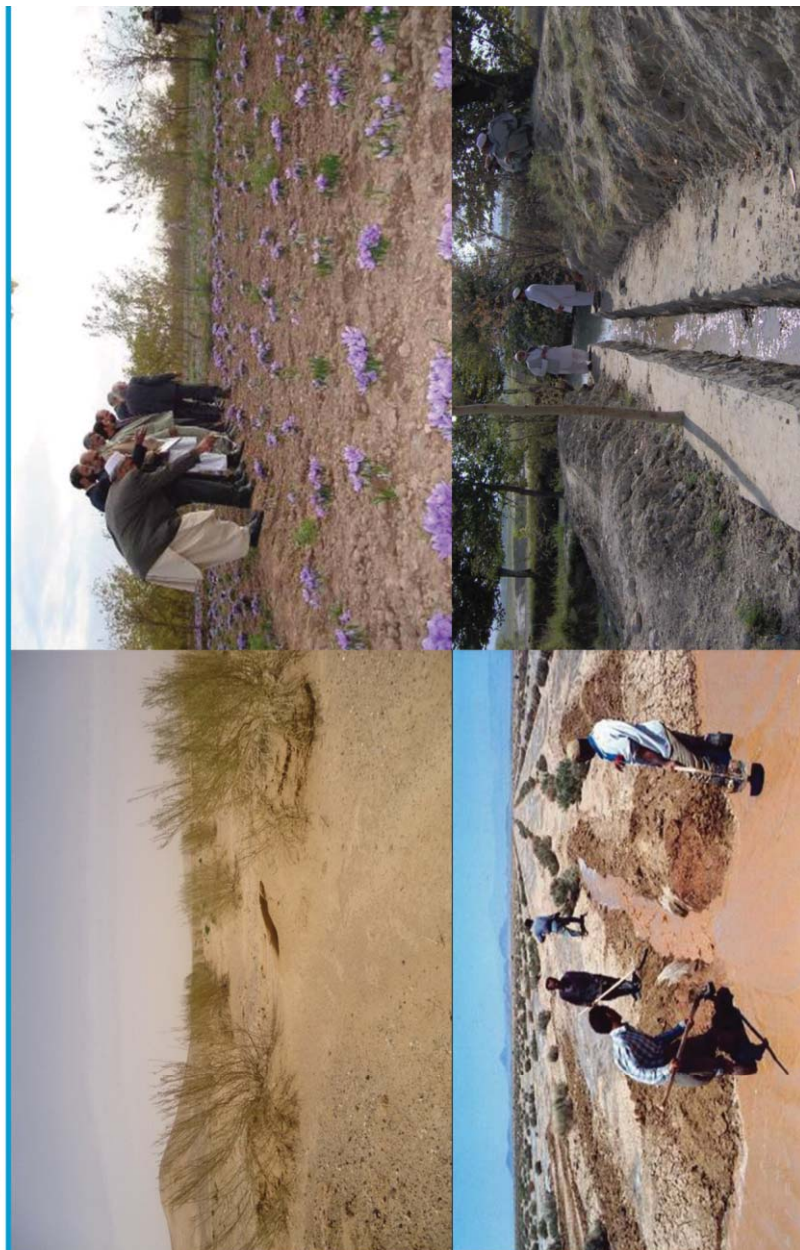






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- Critical factor is working with and listening to communities and building on their strengths.

Eg from Myanmar / China - rubber

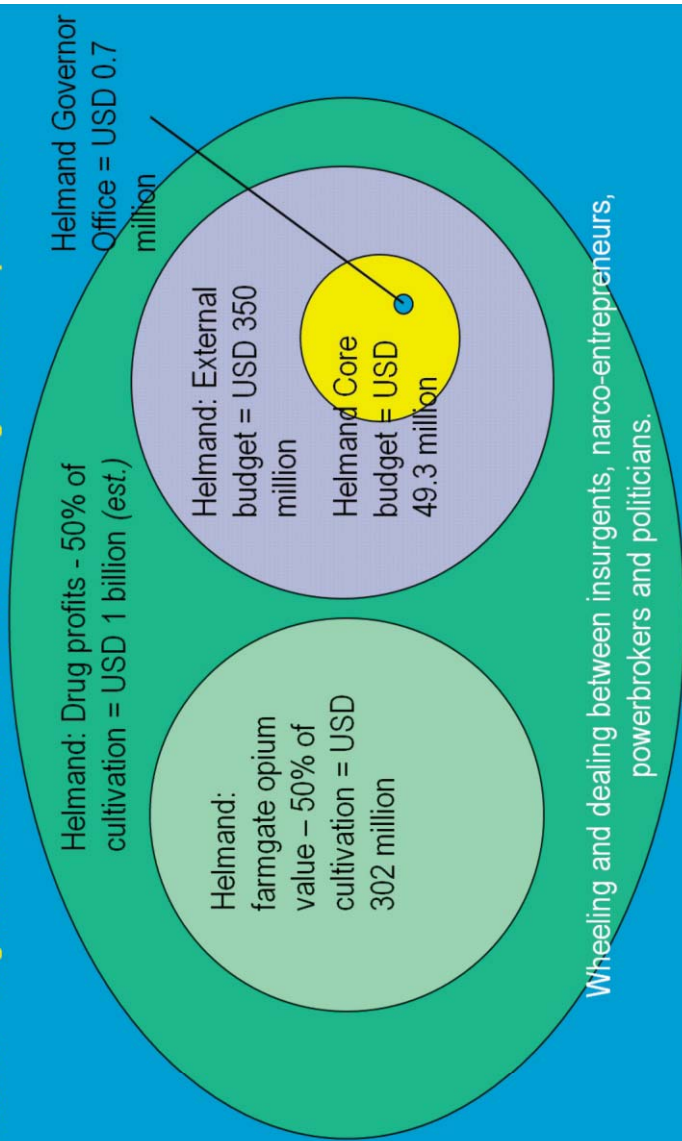


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Context – Magnified in Conflict Affected Provinces: governance post-2014





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NGOs

- There are many national and international NGOs operating in Afghanistan.
- While security can constrain UN agencies and bilateral aid programmes, NGOs often do not have the same restrictions and are able to work in places where the UN can not.
- In our case they often hesitate to engage in drug issue as they see as a security risk
- However, UNODC has many working partnership with NGOs



CN ‘Genuine Mainstreaming’

- UNODC and MCN have struggled to get CN on agenda but are making in-roads.
- Three processes in Afghanistan: Security, Development and Regional
- Development: originally 22 NPPs, but none on CN
- Last 12 months, have AL policies – joint ministry programmes (Food zones) – and CN monitoring mechanism

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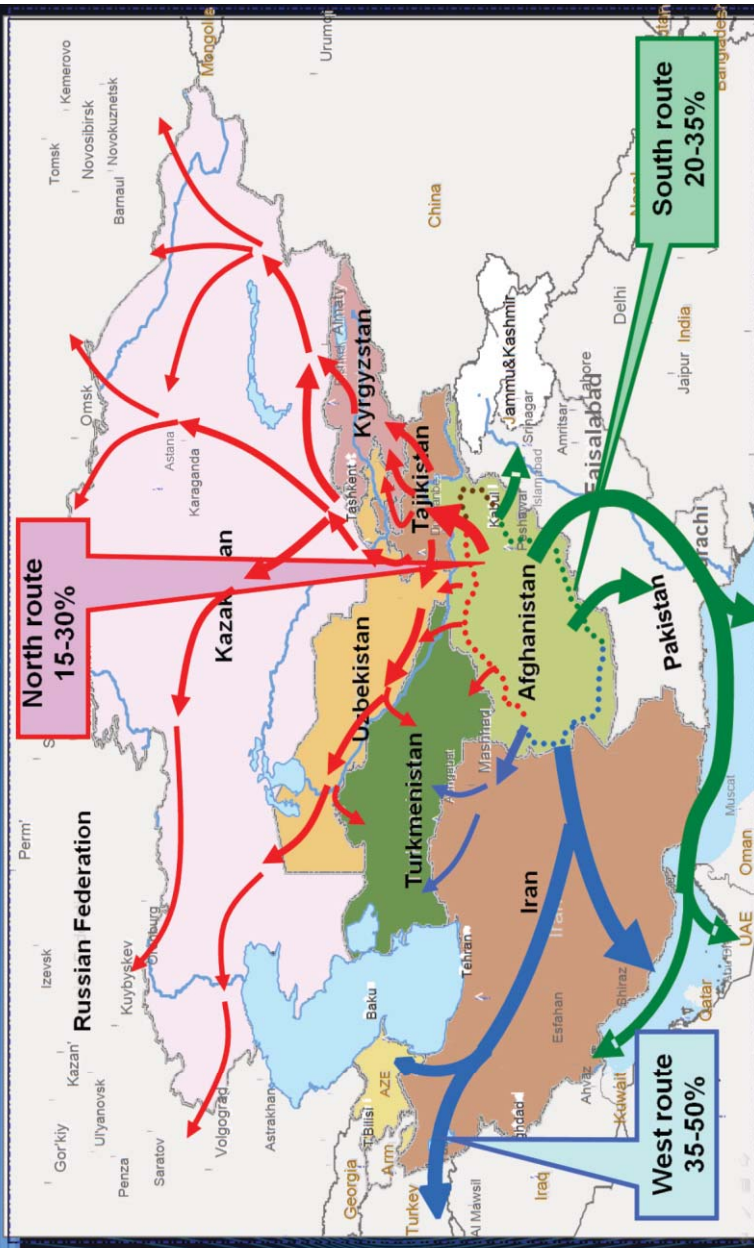
